National service provider strengthens aviation portfolio by securing contract at Orlando International Airport

Houston, TX — November 13, 2006 — Linc Facility Services, LLC (Linc) announced today that it was selected by the Greater Orlando Aviation Authority (GOAA) to provide Fixed Ground Service Equipment Maintenance and Repair Services at the Orlando International Airport (MCO) in Orlando, Florida.
